## **UPDATED HEARING NOTICE**

### **NOTICE OF SUNSET REVIEW OVERSIGHT HEARING OF THE CEMETERY AND FUNERAL BUREAU**

The Senate Committee on Business, Professions, and Economic Development (BP&ED) and the Assembly Committee on Business and Professions (B&P), collectively “the Committees”, will hold joint sunset review oversight hearings on March 18 and March 23, 2015. The Committees are the standing committees of the Legislature that have oversight jurisdiction over the Department of Consumer Affairs (Department) and all agencies and entities under the Department. It is the responsibility of the Committees to determine whether the State should continue to regulate these areas and, if so, what changes should be made to improve the overall effectiveness and efficiency of these entities to ensure that the interests of California consumers are protected against incompetent practice or illegal activities of these professionals.

The oversight hearing for the Cemetery and Funeral Bureau has been changed to **March 18, 2015**, in Rooms 4202 and 4203 of the State Capitol, starting at 9:00 a.m. The room location and starting time have not changed. There are additional sunset hearings also scheduled on this date; it is unknown at this time when the hearing for Cemetery and Funeral Bureau will begin.

The following is a tentative outline of the agenda (subject to change) for each board/bureau under review:

- A. Board/bureau presents short “Overview” of the current regulatory program
- B. Board/bureau responds to issues, problem areas, questions, and staff recommendations
- C. Public comment
- D. Comments by professional individuals, groups, or associations
- E. Closing comments by the board/bureau

Staff of the Committees will prepare a Background Paper to provide background information concerning the issues the Committees have raised for each individual board/bureau and, where appropriate, staff recommendations to address those issues.
